The Eurofins network of companies (further referred to as "we") requires its Suppliers to support its decarbonisation efforts, through:

- › reducing Supplier's own emissions (e.g. renewable energy),
- › supporting Eurofins' emissions targets through accurate reporting at item level (lifecycle assessment) whenever possible,
- › collaborating on eco-friendly solutions and activities throughout our supply chains (e.g. packaging reduction, transport optimisation, recycling).

Eurofins Supplier Code of Ethics

We expect our Suppliers to acknowledge the Eurofins Supplier Code of Ethics and to commit to and implement similar measures across their supply chain.

Supply chain ESG compliance

Key Suppliers working with companies within the Eurofins network must document their ESG (environmental, social, and corporate governance) compliance on an annual basis.
