YOU MAGAZINE LOOSE INSERT SPECIFICATIONS

- Trimmed size of YOU magazine 286mm x 232mm
- No concertina folds can be accepted unless tabbed.
- Due to the mechanical nature of loose inserting, specific positioning cannot be guaranteed.
- All Inserts must be of a uniform thickness along the closed-edge for reliable pick-up on the lines.
- All inserts are inserted with the spine parallel to the host magazine spine, i.e."spine-to-spine"
- The Printer must approve any Insert that deviates from the specification below before a booking is confirmed (such approval not to be unreasonably withheld, delayed or conditioned). The Printer will require "dummies" of the product for testing. No more than 2 wire stitched books.
- The Printer requires an additional 1.0% over and above the net quantity to be inserted into the magazine. However, at quantities less than 75,000 the Printer requires 3% overs.
- The minimum loose Insert quantity is normally 50,000 copies. A charge of £500 per affected run of loose Inserts (as a one-off charge) will be applied for quanties less than 50,000.
- Any post run surplus less than 20,000 copies will not be retained on the Premises indefinitely; but preferably run out during the next scheduled production. If no such Instruction is given these quantities will be destroyed after 14 days.

GENERAL

- All Inserts (Loose or bound-in), or Tip-ons are subject to approval prior to booking (such approval not to be unreasonably withheld, delayed or conditioned), including (without limitation):
- Inserts with UV Varnish or laminate.
- · Irregular shapes.
- Filled envelopes and Inserts with perforations.
- All deliveries must be as per the Printer's Booking-in Procedure and Insert & Onsert Packing specification (as set out in the Exhibit to this Appendix).
- Coded regionalised and zoned Inserts must be notified at the time of booking.
- The calliper of A6 Inserts must be less or equal to 1.5mm. Maximum calliper of any individual Insert should not exceed 1.5mm. The combined maximum calliper of the loose Inserts, bound-in Inserts, tip-on and the host magazine must not exceed 5mm. The total number of inserted pages must not exceed that of the total number of pages of the host product.
- Zoning no more than 3 zoned combinations per region, either inserted or onserted, not both. (For clarity, if YOU magazine
 contains a zoned Insert, the magazines carrying the zoned Insert(s) will effectively become a zoned Onsert.
- Combined maximum weight of any Inserts should not exceed 70g.
