Barracuda Site Security Scanner is an easy-to-use, free tool you can use to scan your customers' sites for various security issues. The scanner crawls a site, the devices in the site, site accounts, and domain policies for security vulnerabilities. You can then generate a PDF report to submit to your customers to help them understand their security vulnerabilities and select products to improve their security.

New in Barracuda Site Security Scanner 1.3

Barracuda Site Security Scanner 1.3 includes UI improvements.

REQUIREMENTS

Before you run a security scan, you need the following:

- An installed and functioning version of Barracuda Site Security Scanner. Click this link to install the Barracuda Site Security Scanner.
 - The Barracuda Site Security Scanner requires one of the following:
 - Windows 10 or higher (64-bit only)
 - Windows Server 2016 or higher (64-bit only)
- A working log in for Barracuda Cloud Control.
- The credentials of a domain admin with rights to access the domain you want to scan.

IMPORTANT

The installer automatically installs the following:

- Visual C++ Redistributable 2015-2022
- Npcap and Nmap applications

A reboot is **not** required after install.

The Barracuda Site Security Scanner scans Windows sites only. Linux and Apple devices are discovered but are automatically excluded from the scan. They are considered unknown devices.

USAGE LIMIT

After 30 days, you can no longer use the Barracuda Site Security Scanner. If you want to use the Barracuda Site Security Scanner again, do the following:

- 1. Uninstall the current version of the Barracuda Site Security Scanner.
- 2. Download a new version of the scanner.
- 3. Install the new version.

The number of days left in your current chusage period is displayed in the bottom left corner of the Barracuda Site Security Scanner window.

TO DOWNLOAD THE BARRACUDA SITE SECURITY SCANNER

- 1. Review the Barracuda Site Security Scanner prerequisites.
- 2. Download the <u>Barracuda Site Security Scanner</u>.
- 3. Go to the folder where you downloaded the Barracuda Site Security Scanner.
- 4. Double-click the .exe to start the install.
