



Adjustment Tips in Hong Kong

(For reference only, please visit the official websites of the information/service providers for the latest updates.)

1. Weather



June-October: range from 30°C to 35°C, rainy, typhoon season

November-February: range from 10°C to 20°C in average, slightly dry



March-May: range from 20°C to 28°C, very humid

Remember to bring a jacket/cardigan to class as the air-conditioning can get quite chilly!

2. Medication



Hong Kong's pharmacies are well-stocked, but if you require prescription medication or prefer specific brands, you may consider bringing it along with you. Insect repellent could be useful in the summer months.

3. Hong Kong Identity (HKID) Card

If a person is a new arrival aged 11 or over and has been permitted to stay in Hong Kong for more than 180 days, he/she must register for a Hong Kong identity card within 30 days of arrival. No fee is charged for identity cards issued to new arrivals.

From a simple way to pay fares on public transport, Octopus has extended its reach into small-value payments in the retail sector as well as many other applications, including government tolled tunnel, parking, access control for residential and commercial building, support for various facilities in schools and self-service kiosks.

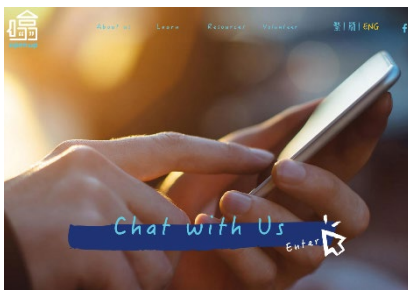
8. Banking Service
