Certifications are developed by analyzing the skills, knowledge and abilities of subject matter experts who use the Tanium platform daily – to ensure professionals who hold certifications have demonstrated proficient use of the Tanium platform.

Candidates can take Tanium certification exams through the global network of Pearson VUE Test Centers or take the exam online using Pearson's On VUE testing service. The cost for each exam is one (1) exam voucher; candidates will have one (1) opportunity per voucher to pass the exam successfully. Exams are time-based. Upon successful completion of an exam, the candidate will receive a score report. Certifications are valid for two (2) years.
