This action amends 3VAC10-20 and 3VAC10-30 to advance public health and safety, provide additional clarity and transparency, and comport with Chapter 812 of the 2023 Acts of Assembly and Chapter 732 of the 2024 Acts of Assembly.

This action adds and amends definitions to provide clarity for terminology such as resident, daycare, school, and material owner. This action also updates the application procedures for pharmaceutical processor permits to reflect updated business standards and practices, specifies when pharmaceutical processor operations commence, and adds requirements for additional cultivation facilities mandated by Chapter 812 of the 2023 Acts of Assembly.

On October 9, 2024, the CCA Board of Directors voted to approve amendments to the regulations of the medical cannabis program.

Mandate and Impetus

The CCA Board of Directors determined it was necessary to amend the medical cannabis program regulations to clarify ambiguities that have resulted in numerous inquiries to CCA staff, properly address current practices, and comport with Chapter 812 of the 2023 Acts of Assembly and Chapter 732 of the 2024 Acts of Assembly.
