Compliance Monitoring - WGBH is also responsible for monitoring the subrecipient's compliance with applicable laws and regulations. This can be accomplished in multiple ways. Annually, WGBH will send a questionnaire to all known subrecipients requesting a copy of their most recent Single Audit report and other information. Responses will be sent back to WGBH's Compliance department, which will review the results and follow up on any findings identified.
