"The Curse Breakers" Celebrating 20 years since the Red Sox ended their 86-year World Series drought

WHAT:

Twenty years ago, The Red Sox did something no baseball team had ever done — or has since — when they rallied down 3-0 to beat the hated Yankees in the ALCS. Then, it was onto a four-game sweep of the Cardinals to hoist the World Series trophy. Prior to 2004, it had been 86 long years since the Red Sox won the World Series. Many were starting to believe they'd never see it happen again.
