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GlobeDocs Film Festival to Celebrate 10th Year Anniversary

Boston's only all-documentary film festival returns in-person and online October 22-27

(Boston, MA – October 1, 2024) – The GlobeDocs Film Festival, Boston's only all-documentary festival, has officially announced the lineup for its 10th year anniversary which will take place in-person and virtually from October 22 through 27, 2024, marking an expansion to six days. Produced by *The Boston Globe* and presented by Cross Insurance, the festival will feature over 30 films from award-winning filmmakers and conversations with *Boston Globe* journalists as well as guests from around the globe.

The lineup includes 16 feature-length and 16 short documentary films curated by Lisa Viola, Director of Programming for GlobeDocs, highlighting a wide range of current topics including politics, LGBTQ+ and women's issues, mental health, the arts, BIPOC voices, social justice, and immigration. In-person screenings will take place at the Coolidge Corner Theatre in Brookline, Brattle Theatre in Cambridge, and Alamo Drafthouse Cinema Boston Seaport. Virtual screenings are presented via the Eventive platform and are accessible to viewers anywhere in the U.S.

The festival will open with the World Premiere of DUKAKIS: RECIPE FOR DEMOCRACY, directed and produced by Erin Trahan and Jeff Schmidt, on Tuesday, October 22 at the Coolidge Corner Theatre. The film offers an intimate look at the unflappable former Massachusetts governor three decades after his historic presidential bid and will feature a Q&A with honored guests.

This year's Centerpiece film is 2073, directed by Academy Award®-winning Asif Kapadia (*Amy*), a sci-fi, hybrid film that connects modern day journalists conveying current global crises with a dystopian future outlook starring Samantha Morton and screening on Friday October 25 at the Brattle Theatre.

Closing out the festival will be the New England Premiere of ZURAWSKI V TEXAS, directed by Maisie Crow and Abbie Perrault, on Sunday, October 27 at the Brattle Theatre. Championed by executive producers Hillary Clinton and Jennifer Lawrence, ZURAWSKI V TEXAS takes one of the nation's most pressing issues and shows how women denied abortions under Texas's

ambiguous and unforgiving bans come together with a fearless attorney to sue the government.

Additionally, this year GlobeDocs will celebrate new local talent through the inaugural Emerging Filmmaker contest where filmmakers ages 18-25 were encouraged to submit a short original film to be featured in this year's festival. This year's winner, LIGHTHOUSE, directed by Boston College student Lola Ellis, will be screened as part of the program *Local Shorts: What We See* on Sunday, October 27 at the Brattle Theatre.

Screenings will be followed by in-person or virtual discussions with filmmakers, moderated by accomplished *Boston Globe* journalists. Festival-goers will also have the opportunity to vote for the annual Audience Award which is awarded to one feature film and one short film.

"Over the past 10 years, GlobeDocs has grown to become a renowned festival that convenes filmmakers with thought leaders, local journalists, and audiences for timely discussions on important stories and topics that impact our daily lives," said **Linda Henry**, CEO of Boston Globe Media.
