4. Transport and access

- Airport: Queen Alia International Airport is located approximately 35 km south of Amman's city center. Travel time is about 45 minutes by taxi or shuttle.
- Taxi: Taxis are available outside the airport terminal. It is recommended to use official taxi services for reliability.
- Public Transport: Amman has a network of buses, and apps like "Careem" and "Uber" are widely used for convenient transportation.

5. Visas



Visitors to Jordan may require a visa depending on their nationality. It is recommended to check with the Jordanian Embassy or Consulate in your home country regarding visa requirements. Or you can check the following link for restricted nationalities that need a visa or not

6. Currency, time, climate etc.

- The official currency of Jordan is the Jordanian Dinar. Visa, American Express, Access/MasterCard, and Diners Club cards can also be used. Banks are opened from Sunday till Thursday, from 8.30 to 15.00.
- Daytime highs usually range from 10°C to 15°C (50°F to 59°F), while nighttime lows can drop to around 2°C to 6°C (36°F to 43°F). It's colder in the evenings and early mornings.
- Greenwich Mean Time (GMT/UTC):

Standard Time: Jordan is 2 hours ahead of GMT (UTC +2). Daylight Saving Time: Jordan is 3 hours ahead of GMT (UTC +3).

• United States (Eastern Time - ET):

Standard Time: Jordan is 7 hours ahead of Eastern Standard Time (EST, UTC -5). Daylight Saving Time: Jordan is 6 hours ahead of Eastern Daylight Time (EDT, UTC -4) when both Jordan and the U.S. are observing daylight saving time.
