



The Language Proficiency Certificate

is a Requirement for Application Process Starting from the Upcoming Academic Year 2025-2024

The following categories are eligible to apply for admission to postgraduate programs starting from the academic year 2025-2024:

- Applicants who have achieved the required score or higher in the International English Language Testing System (IELTS) Academic Exam or the International Test of English as a Foreign Language (TOEFL-IBT), whether they are applying to programs taught in Arabic or programs taught in English.
- Programs taught in English:
 - Applicants for doctoral programs who have achieved a score of 5.5 in the IELTS Academic Exam or a score of 69 in the TOEFL-IBT must pass the English language courses LANC6001 and LANC6003 before starting their studies in the program they are admitted in. The IELTS or TOEFL scores should be valid for a period of two years from the date of the exam result until the application submission date.
 - Applicants for master's programs who have achieved a score of 5.5 in the IELTS Academic Exam or a score of 69 in the TOEFL-IBT must pass the English language course LANK6000 before starting their studies in the program they are admitted in. The IELTS or TOEFL scores should be valid for a period of two years from the date of the exam result until the application submission date.
