Parade Rules

ATTENTION Parade Participants,

We are excited to have you participate in our Centennial Homecoming Parade on Saturday morning, Nov. 9, 2024. However, we respectfully ask that you abide by the following rules:

- Please arrive in the designated holding area and lineup sections by 06:50 am CST.
- Each entry will receive their lineup card at the point of entrance.
- When the campus entrance closes for parade participants, you will not be allowed entrance onto the campus. **NO EXCEPTIONS**
- All participants are asked to enter the campus at the **Franklin Road entrance (West Gate)** beginning as early as 06:00 am CST.
- If you are coming from in and around Tuskegee, go directly to the **Franklin Road entrance (West Gate)**. Police officers and signage will be posted to direct participants to the Franklin Road Gate.
- If you are traveling North or South on Interstate 85, we ask that you take **Exit 32, not Exit 38** and follow the signage to the **Franklin Road entrance (West Gate)**.
- When you enter the Franklin Road Gate, we ask that your unit is already decorated and parade-ready. You will be directed to your position in the lineup.
- If you enter the gate and you need to drop someone off for the lineup, please go directly to the **holding area** and escort your drop-off person to where he or she needs to be. After you have properly dropped off your parade participant, we ask that you promptly proceed to the parade ending site at the **Vacant Lot adjacent to Burger King or the Burger King Parking Lot at 504 North Main Street, Tuskegee, AL 36083** to pick up your parade participant. If someone must return to the campus, please use the VA Road at the Valero service station past Burger King. Take the VA Road to the North Gate and enter campus by turning left on Frederick Patterson Lane next to the Veterinary Hospital.
- All units in the parade must be decorated, and we ask that you display the Parade Theme which is “**100 Years of Investing in Homecoming-The Tuskegee Way**”.
- As parade assistants place you in the lineup, please keep to the far right-hand side of the street.
- All vehicle drivers in the parade must have liability insurance.
- **LIMIT 5 VEHICLES per entry (the only exception is Car Clubs).**
- Throwing candy and other objects is not allowed in the parade. You may hand out items while walking in or alongside a unit.
- We ask that participants not ride on the hoods, trunks or atop vehicles.
- Off-road vehicles are not allowed in the parade (ATV/Crouch Rockers).
- All Bands are asked to perform for 30 seconds at the **President’s Viewing Stand**.
- Please keep up with the parade to avoid gaps in the lineup.
- **This is a long parade.** So, please make sure you are prepared to assist children and the elderly who are walking in the parade. The length of the route is approximately 2 ½ miles one way.
