

How to Drop or Withdraw from Classes

Before you begin the actual process of dropping or withdrawing, there are some very important details to consider.

First:

Before dropping a class, sometimes merely speaking with your instructor might ease your mind and there may not be a need to drop it at all. You may be doing better academically than you think OR after conferring with your instructor you may mutually decide on strategies that may help improve your performance. Second:

Always contact the Office of Financial Aid and the Business Office for details concerning any potential change to your financial obligations due to dropping a class.



Remember, once the semester begins, any changes to your class schedule could affect your financial aid eligibility or generate additional fees you may have to pay out-of-pocket.



Third:

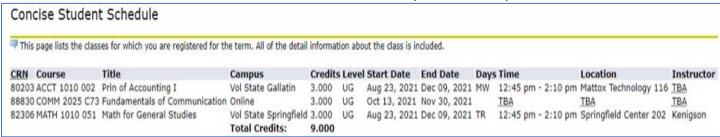
Each semester has classes that start and end at different Parts of the Term. Refund and Withdrawal Deadlines differ for each Part of Term. Check your schedule to determine the Part of Term.



To view your class schedule log into My Vol State, click on the Advising & Registration folder, then click on the View Student Schedule app.



Select the Term and Save. Review the Start and End Date of the class you wish to drop.



Visit the <u>Advising Resources webpage</u> (https://www.volstate.edu/advising/resources) to view the "Dates to Remember" for the current semester. Find the appropriate Part of Term for your course and review the Refund & Withdrawal Deadlines.

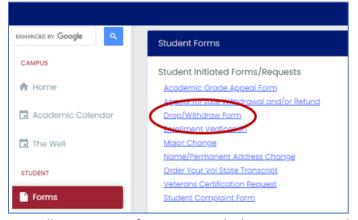
Fourth:

Complete the electronic Drop/Withdraw form and Submit. (Use your Concise Student Schedule again to complete the course details on the form.)



You will receive a confirmation email when your request has been processed.
