 - Login, DO NOT CLICK on 'Get Your VA Benefit Letters'!
 Scroll down to "What if I want to download a letter or document that isn't available from this tool?"
 Click Download Your VA Education Letters

• Tuition Assistance (TA)

 Be advised/register for classes with our office; access Army Ignited (CAC req.) - submit degree plan for approval; request TA no sooner than 60 & no later than 7 days prior to classes start. www.military.com/education/money-for-school/tuition-assistance-ta-program-overview.html

TN Strong Act

 Commander's signature, SCO completes part, then submit completed application packet to TN Strong Act manager. www.tn.gov/military/programs-benefits/educationincentives/state-ta.html

- DD214 Member 4 copy to our office OR verification of successful Basic Military Training/Boot Camp

STEP 4: OUR OFFICE REQUIREMENTS

- Certificate of Eligibility (COE) Email/give a copy to us
- Submit VCRF (Veterans Certification Request form)
 - Access VCRF online form in My Vol State student portal, then Student Forms app
 - Provide each semester if using VA education benefits
- · Connect with our office:
 - Advising/registration, benefits information, questions
 - BEFORE changing schedule after the semester starts
 - ALWAYS update us if your schedule changes!
